The **ENERGY GLOBE AWARD** is the world's most prestigious and respected environmental award. The awards in 5 categories (sometimes 6) have been presented for 8 years to projects that implement a prudent and economical use of resources and/or efficiently employ alternative energy sources. The 5 project categories are earth, fire, water, air – representative of the basic element of life – and youth.

The award presentations are held within the framework of gala award ceremonies at regional, national and international levels such as in all 9 federal states of Austria as well as **95 states around the world**. In 2006 more than 700 projects from around the globe participated in the ENERGY GLOBE AWARD competition. On April 11, 2007 the current highlight of this private Austrian initiative will take place at the Hemicycle of the European Parliament in Brussels. This follows gala ceremonies at the Expo in Japan in 2005 and in Vancouver, Canada at the Globe Fair in 2006. The major decision makers in Europe will attend this TV gala, which will be broadcast throughout Europe and internationally by 3sat and the EBU reaching more than three billion households.

The ENERGY GLOBE AWARDS are an invaluable contribution to helping find solutions to a better future as well as building awareness regarding the many obstacles we currently have to overcome in order to help our endangered environment.
